MASS MEETING

I, Chapman Good, Chairman of the Page County Republican Committee, pursuant to the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia, and recommended and directed by the Committee, do hereby issue this notice and call for a Mass Meeting of the Page County Republican Committee, to be held on Tuesday, April 28, 2026 at the Stanley Volunteer Fire Department at 190 East Main Street, Stanley, Virginia starting at 6:30PM with registration beginning at 6:00PM for the following purpose:

1. To Elect the following positions within the Page County Republican Committee (“Unit”):
 - a. Chairman,
 - b. First Vice Chairman,
 - c. Second Vice Chairman,
 - d. Secretary,
Treasurer.
2. To select members for the Page County Republican Committee.
3. To select Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen for each of the 5 precincts from within the Unit.
4. Transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Mass Meeting.
5. Adjournment

Qualifications and Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Page County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or gender, who are in the accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the

ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meeting, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election to Party office (those listed in Paragraph 1 above) shall state their intention, via letter, delivered by mail or in Person to Stephanie Breeden, Unit Secretary, at the Page County Commonwealth's Attorney's Office, 116 South Court St, Luray, VA 22835. The form must be received no later than 5:00pm, Thursday, April 9, 2026.

If only one candidate properly pre-files for the nomination for an office then such properly filed person shall be deemed nominated and no further process to fill the vacancy be needed.

Membership Term and Fee

Members of the Committee shall be elected for two years. The fee for each year shall be \$30. Each applicant shall pay the fee by the date of the Mass Meeting. Applicants may pay for the entire two-year term.

Registration Fee

Proper ID is required. There is no registration fee for the Mass Meeting.

Proper Notice

The Call for this Mass Meeting is herewith published on the Republican Party of Virginia website, social media sites, in the local newspaper on March 26, 2026, and forwarded to the Sixth Congressional District Committee. Copies of the Call were sent via email to all members of the Page County Republican committee and the Chairman of the Sixth District.
